

## 4 TRAININGS

1. **Orientation** briefing is provided on overall country briefing, health policy plan development, health sector financing as well as monitoring and evaluation.
2. Classroom **instructions** on primary health care, health extension program implementation
3. Hands-on **experiential class room instruction** is provided that is customized to various audiences
4. **Site visits** and on-the-ground experience sharing are conducted on Ethiopia's Health Extension Program, Health Development Army and Model Families.
5. Participants will be provided (either hard or soft copies) of **vital documents** of the Health Sector Transformation Plan, training materials, monitoring and evaluation guidelines, prevention and treatment guidelines, strategic documents, etc.



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## CURRENT TRAINING PROGRAMS

### **Policy makers (3 days training)**

Including : parliamentarians, health ministers, lawyers, health and economic advisors

### **Health programmers (2 weeks training)**

Including : Ministerial, Regional and provincial health managers

### **Primary Health Care Implementers (6 weeks training)**

Including : District , health center level managers and professionals

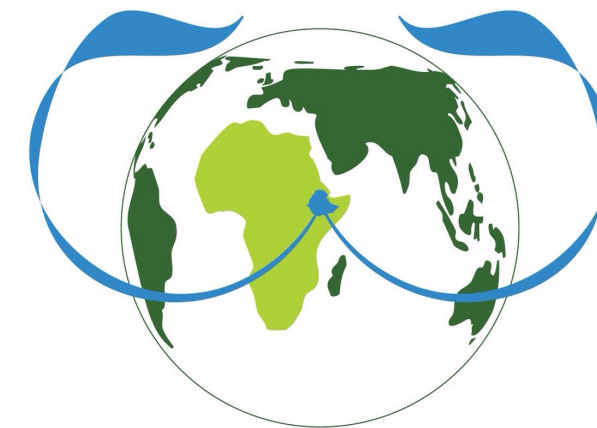
